State-of-the-Art Reports (STARs) provide useful novel overviews of research in computer graphics and related fields. They are essentially survey papers in important areas that have not been covered before or recently. Their aim is to give a detailed account of the principles, algorithms and open problems of a research area, so that an interested reader can quickly acquire a grasp of that area.

This year we received fourteen high-quality and well-written STAR submissions which were all peerreviewed. Among them we had to select just six STARs for the EG09 programme. The selection was difficult particularly because it was necessary to consider, apart from the review scores, the construction of a balanced and attractive STAR programme. Topics range from HDR imaging, texture synthesis, modeling of urban space, visualization ToF acquisition to character animation

The speakers are leaders in their fields and we are thus convinced that this year's STAR programme is particularly attractive.
